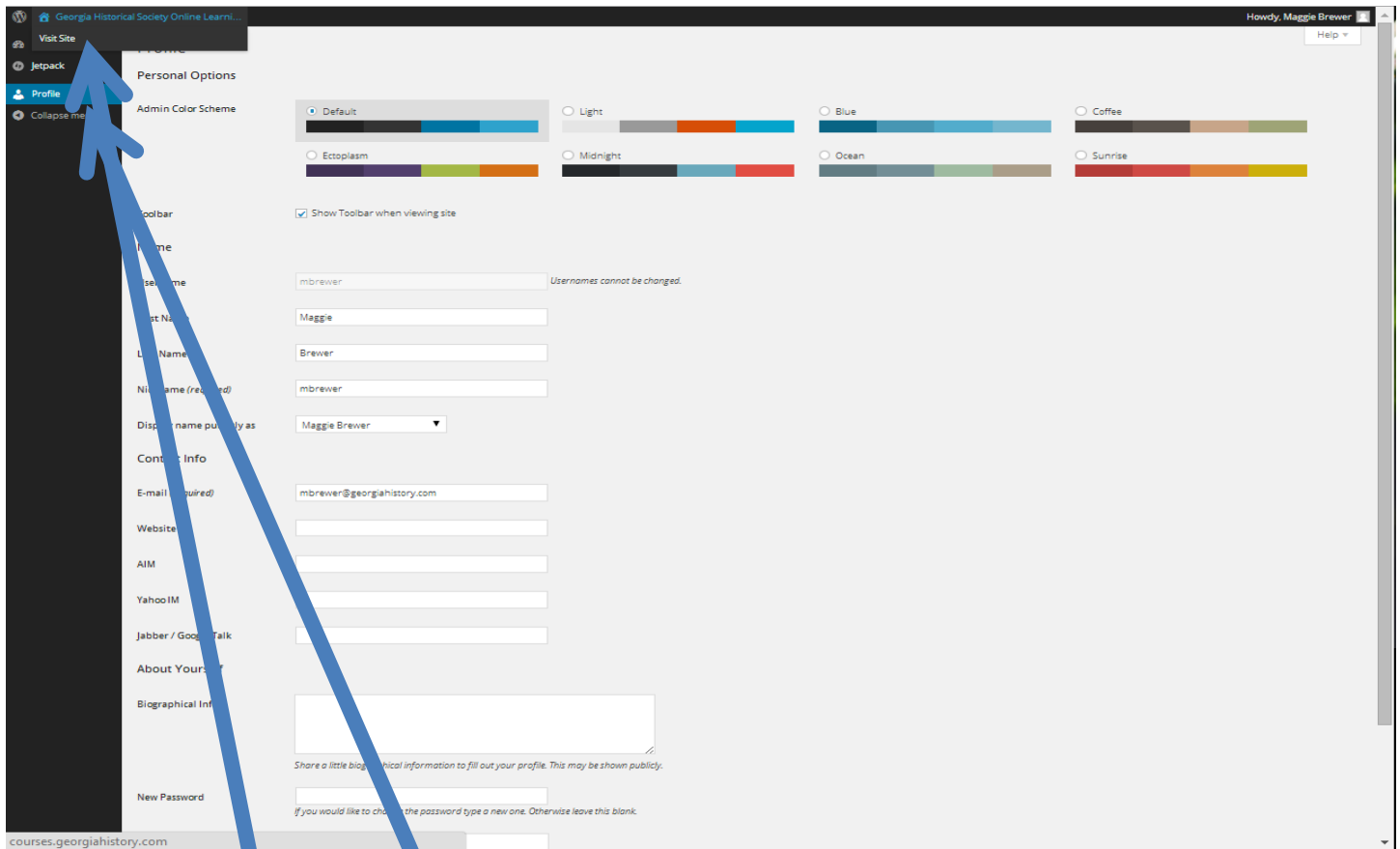
You will use one username and password for the GHS Online Learning website, but you will only be able to access course content for courses you are enrolled in.
